Spring time brings many recurring things. Yes the plants are up and my little Trillium patch is looking great. I found it years ago in the little wooded area by my house and slowly collected and moved individual plants together. To be honest, back in the day, I took a class called "Spring Flora of Wisconsin." I had already graduated and was teaching but needed more credits and it sounded interesting.

The first class I was told each week we will be exposed to a number of plants and the final exam will be 50 plants and we will be required to name the genus and species. Easy I thought, I'm a college grad as I looked over the class of mostly underclassmen. I did not pay that great of attention that first night; however, after the first class and the plants piled up I realized I better get serious. I did and by the time of the final I was ready. I ended up getting a 92/100 (A-). I learned something real important in that class. Arrogance is not helpful.

Then there is the spring cleanup. Plants, mulch, twigs, and the garage! You may have heard Lori and I bought a second home near Rhinelander. One attractive thing about the home was a detached garage (20 x 30). Well the owners left more than they should have. The last weekend we were up I managed to clean a 5' x 5' front right corner. There I found a LOT of chain! Who needs that much chain of all different sizes? Well of the 600 sq. ft. I've now got 25 done 😞.

Finally there are our bikes. We check the tire pressure, the brakes, and the tire tread. We check the oil and top it off with fresh, ideally NO Ethanol gas and turn it over. Oh the sound brings joy back to my heart. Perhaps your maps need updating. Mine are a 2023 and need some updating. I remember leading a ride traveling west on Hwy. 16/19 and coming up to Hwy. 26. I had Lori confirm what I saw on the Nav ... we were driving through a field and then a lake with NO road beneath us! That was the clue to update my 2017 maps! We hope to have more info on this for all in the near future. The bike wash comes next getting all the winter dust off. Putting the 2026 HOG handbook and the Flat Rocker cover in the saddle bag and don't forget the first aid kit! Have you checked yours lately for anything outdated? I always bring mine in for the winter as I don't want the fluids to freeze. Within the first couple rides of the season I stop at the dealership to get my mileage logged. I'm closing in on 100,000 miles. Yes, spring bike chores are upon us.

In spring we also start to see riding opportunities, the VFW benefit ride just occurred, Rock Wisconsin for Iowa is ready to head out, Minnesota Driftless is sold out, and Passport and Sculpture Tour are taking their first reservations at this Chapter Meeting. SAFETY and ABATE

Hello R.R. Family Members.

Riding season is definitely here, so let's enjoy some fun in the sun and get out and ride. Another way you can tell it's nice outside.....our lawmakers are wrapping up their session in Madison for summer. But we at ABATE are still working to protect our freedom to ride and most importantly our safety.

There was a meeting held in Madison with the UWM Autonomous Vehicle Research Department and Steve P. The Legislative Director from ABATE was there. Steve watched a video that UWM made of an autonomous vehicle driving on a selected route showing the advancement of the technology. There were arrows in the video pointing out people walking, trees, and bicycle riders. During the video there was a pink arrow that would show up occasionally but nothing was identified by it. At the end of the video during the Q&A part, Steve asked about the pink arrow that showed up. The UWM research department had no solid answer, thus proving our point that the autonomous vehicle technology is not 100% full proof. Autonomous vehicles are going to happen. There's a lot of money pushing this technology forward. We as motorcyclists need to get ahead of this and make sure our lawmakers understand what's at stake. Laws need to be written so that the technology put into autonomous vehicles is absolutely undeniably 100% full proof in identifying motorcycles on the road is a must!

Shifting gears. I would like to thank everyone who came out to ABATE's 1F 5th Annual "Knock the Rust Off" riding event! Gary K. had 4 riding skill courses set up. These courses were also designed for trikes. I was happy to see some new riders show up to sharpen their skills. That's what this is about. The weather was not perfect but no rain made it a good day!

FYI, next year we will be doing our 6th annual Knock the Rust Off on April 24th.

At the time this article is being written, there were already 10 motorcycle fatalities this year. In my opinion that's 10 too many. I know accidents are bound to happen, but some just can be avoided. When I read about the accident being caused by excessive speed, losing control of your

motorcycle because you were riding over your abilities or impaired riding, those are no accidents. Those are bad decisions that the rider made and will impact their families and friends for a very long time. To me riding a motorcycle is the best way to decompress and enjoy the sights and smells of nature. Ok, maybe not riding by a farmer spreading manure on his fields. LOL

Listening to your favorite song feeling the engine push you through the backroads, it's a feeling only motorcycle enthusiasts can relate to. So, please ride your own ride. Don't ride over your abilities. Please don't drink and ride!

Riding season has begun! Don't forget to stop in at Wisconsin Harley Davidson to get your first mileage reading of the year. The staff is prepared and ready to help you. Make sure you have downloaded the Harley app using your HOG number, username and password ahead of time.
